Recognising that:


- 1. the goal of achieving a corruption-free Malaysia requires the commitment of every citizen to fight corruption, practice good governance and uphold integrity; and

## **Guidance**

1. Candidates should ensure that public funds, resources and facilities are not used for campaigning.
2. Candidates should adhere to the Election Offences Act 1954 and regulations, including, but not limited to, Election Spending Limits and vote buying regulations.
3. Candidates and elected representatives should ensure that their actions and decisions are for the benefit of the general public and are not self-serving. They should practise transparency and openness through full disclosure to and free access to information by the public.
